Rules:

1. This tournament is open to all USBC youth and adult members in good standing. Team captains are responsible for check in.
2. **This event will be scratch.**
3. Entry Fee will be \$150.00 per entry (\$50 per person - \$25.00 lineage/expenses & \$25.00 prize fund per person). Prize fund will be paid out 100% in scholarships, managed by SMART Acct #9009. Any adult bowler winnings will be distributed to the youth team members. Awards will be awarded on a ratio of at least 1:4.
4. Entries must be postmarked no later than February 23, 2026 or hand carried and received at the South Sound USBC office no later than 4:00 pm on February 26, 2026.
5. Entering Average: Entrants will use averages in the following order:
 - a. A bowler having both a Sport or Challenge and a Standard average we will use the higher of the two without conversion.
 - b. Current average as of March 1, 2026 with 12 games or more for youth, 21 games or more for Adults.
 - c. Highest USBC 2024/2025 average of 12 games or more for youth, 21 games or more for Adults.
 - d. In the event a bowler only has a challenge or sport league average, the average must be converted using the USBC Challenge or Sport conversion chart found on BOWL.com.
 - e. If no established average, females will be assigned 180 and males 200.
 - f. USBC Rule319a(2) – 10-pin rule does not apply
 - g. Failure to report an accurate average will result in disqualification.
6. Teams must consist of three (3) bowlers, at least two (2) of the three (3) bowlers must be youth. **Each team must have at least one female.** Teams may consist of three (3) youth bowlers **that include one female.**
7. Teams will bowl six games with games 3 and 6 being position round. Points will be awarded by most pins over or if both under the closest to average with a head to head format and total pins will be awarded for the teams with most pins over or if both under closest to team average. There are five (5) possible points per game, one (1) point per individual game & two (2) points for team game. In case of a tie for first place there will be a one (1) game roll-off and any other ties will divide the scholarship money awarded evenly.
8. When bowling against a “Bye” team, you will bowl against the scores from the team on the even lane of the pair on your left.
9. Tournament manager must be notified of any changes (substitutes) at check-in. **The line-up you submit will be the line-up you use throughout the whole tournament.**
10. All bowlers must check in 30 minutes prior to squad start in dress code.
11. Bowlers that arrive late shall begin play with the frame being bowled. Frames missed will be given zero.
